

ORDINANCE NO. 60

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE NORTHFIELD WOODS SANITARY DISTRICT APPROPRIATING MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR MAY 1, 1972 TO APRIL 30, 1973.

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Northfield Woods Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois:

Section 1: That for the purpose of defraying all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Northfield Woods Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois, for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 1972 and ending April 30, 1973, the following sums, or so much thereof as by law may be authorized, be and the same are hereby set aside and appropriated for the following purposes, to-wit:

Fees - District Superintendent	\$ 3,000.00
Maintenance of sewer - labor	2,500.00
Maintenance of sewer - material	2,000.00
Operating Expenses - sewer	3,000.00
Collector and bookkeeper	2,400.00
Auditing of books	900.00
Attorney's fees	3,000.00
Trustee's fees	3,000.00
Office expense and telephone	100.00
Office supplies, stationery, postage and printing	100.00
Premium on bond	30.00
Election expenses	120.00
Publication of legal notices	100.00
Reserve for contingencies	<u>600.00</u>
GRAND TOTAL	\$20,850.00

Section 2: That any unexpended balance of any items of any appropriations made by this ordinance may be expended in making any insufficiency in any other item of appropriation made by this ordinance.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
