

ORDINANCE NO. 99

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE PURPOSE AND RESPONSIBILITIES
OF THE NORTHFIELD WOODS SANITARY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the NORTHFIELD WOODS SANITARY DISTRICT, Cook County, Illinois, was, on May 1, 1956, pursuant to Illinois Statutes and by proceedings had in a manner and form as provided by law, organized pursuant to an Order of the County Court of Cook County in Case No. 56 Co 1240 entitled "The Petition to Organize Certain Territory into the Northfield Woods Sanitary District"; and

WHEREAS, the said District was, by the aforementioned Order, authorized to construct and operate a sanitary sewer system in and for said District and to enact and enforce all regulations and ordinances necessary to render such sewage of the District harmless to the public health, safety, welfare and comfort and convenience of the residents of this District, and for the improvement, care and protection of said system; and

WHEREAS, the installation and maintenance of sewers, conduits, pipes, tanks and plants for the collection, disposal, treatment and purification of sewage is within the sole jurisdiction of the NORTHFIELD WOODS SANITARY DISTRICT: and

WHEREAS, since the date of the organization of the NORTHFIELD WOODS SANITARY DISTRICT, said District has operated continuously for the sole purpose of constructing, operating, maintaining and controlling a sanitary sewage system in and for said District, and to enact and enforce all ordinances and regulations necessary to operate the said District; and

WHEREAS, since the date of the organization of the District, substantial growth and development of the property has taken place in and around the boundaries of the District; and certain governmental agencies have attempted to exercise control over the governmental activities of the District, all to the detriment of the District, its property owners and residents; and

WHEREAS, the District feels it is necessary to the proper functioning of the District and in the best interests of the District, its property owners and residents, that the purpose of the District be restated;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the NORTHFIELD WOODS SANITARY DISTRICT:

1. That the sole purpose of the organization and continued operation of the aforementioned District was and is the construction, operation, maintenance and control of a sanitary sewage system within the boundaries of the District as the same may from time to time be required to meet the needs of the property owners and residents of the District.

2. All District funding, appropriations, levies and bonded indebtedness have been and continue to be for the aforementioned organizational purpose.

3. Any expansion of the District's responsibilities would be in direct contravention to the intent of the original organizational purpose of the District, would result in substantial expense to the District, would threaten the principal well-being of the District and would not be in the best interests of the property owners and residents of the District.

4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided for by law.
