

ORDINANCE NO. 138

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE NORTHFIELD WOODS SANITARY DISTRICT
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 92 OF THE
NORTHFIELD WOODS SANITARY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 92 was adopted December 11, 1979, and amended July 14, 1980, by Ordinance No. 96, by the Board of Trustees of the NORTHFIELD WOODS SANITARY DISTRICT, (hereinafter referred to as the "District") Cook County, Illinois, for the purpose of requiring the installation and maintenance of grease traps in all commercial and industrial locations within the District; requiring a permit for said installations and a permit fee therefor; requiring inspections thereof and an inspection fee therefor; providing the granting of variations upon certain findings of fact and establishing penalties for the failure to comply with the provisions of the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the District, together with the District's Superintendent and Consulting Engineer, have reviewed the provisions of said Ordinance as regards the types and sizes of grease traps necessary for the proper operation the District's sewage system; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the District does hereby find that a revision and clarification of the regulations for the installation and maintenance of grease traps are in the best interest of the District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the NORTHFIELD WOODS SANITARY DISTRICT, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: REPEAL.

That Ordinance No. 92 adopted December 11, 1979, and amended July 14, 1980, by Ordinance No. 96 be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY.

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: ORDINANCE IN FORCE.

This Ordinance, after its passage, shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after its publication or posting as provided by law.
