

ORDINANCE NO. 23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE NORTHFIELD WOODS SANITARY DISTRICT APPROPRIATING MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR MAY 1, 1960 TO APRIL 30, 1961

BE IT ORDAINED By the President and Board of Trustees of the Northfield Woods Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois:

SECTION 1: That for the purpose of defraying all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Northfield Woods Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois, for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 1960 and ending April 30, 1961, the following sums, or so much thereof as by law may be authorized, be and the same are hereby set aside and appropriated for the following purposes, to-wit:

Auditing of books	400.00
Reserve for contingencies	150.00
Fees - District Superintendent	1,200.00
Maintenance of sewer - Labor	1,000.00
Maintenance of sewer - Material	500.00
Office expense	240.00
Office supplies, stationery, printing, postage	100.00
Premium on bond	50.00
Publication of legal notice	100.00
Telephone expense	60.00

GRAND TOTAL OF APPROPRIATIONS \$ 5,200.00


SECTION 2: That any unexpended balance of any items of any appropriations made by this ordinance may be expended in making any insufficiency in any other item of appropriation made by this ordinance.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
