

ORDINANCE NO. 40

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1(g) OF  
ORDINANCE NO. 13 TO PROVIDE A PERMIT FEE  
OF \$10.00 FOR EACH RESIDENCE OR BUILDING  
TO USE THE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 13 adopted September 26, 1957 the Northfield Woods Sanitary District, Cook County, Illinois in Section 1(g) established a fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for a permit for each residence or building to use the said sanitary sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the costs of the District have increased since the adoption of said ordinance and the Board of Trustees find it in the public interest to increase the cost for said permit fee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE NORTHFIELD WOODS SANITARY DISTRICT, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That Section 1(g) - Fees of Ordinance No. 13, an ordinance entitled: "AN ORDINANCE regulating the installation and maintenance of pipes, conduits, sewers, tanks, plants and combinations thereof for the collection, disposal, treatment, purification of sewage and requiring a permit for any new installation and for inspection thereof; and establishing a permit fee therefor: requiring an annual license to be obtained for the maintenance of certain pipes, conduits, sewers and tanks and for inspection thereof; and establishing a license fee therefor: requiring a permit for the connection of certain pipes, conduits and sewers to a sewage system now under construction; and establishing a permit fee therefor" be and the same is hereby amended to and

shall hereafter read as follows:

"Section 1(g): Every person, firm or corporation issued a permit pursuant to Section 1(a) of this Ordinance shall pay to the Sanitary District a fee of \$10.00 for each residence or building to use the sanitary sewer system.<sup>x</sup> The fees herein provided are to cover the cost to the District of the issuance of permits and the cost of the necessary supervision, inspection and regulation of installations and erections of pipes, conduits, sewers, septic tanks, sewage plants or combinations thereof, or other equipment, as provided for by the terms of this Ordinance."

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
